On the 5th of June we held our Strengthening Families Event at the Frenchville Sports Club.



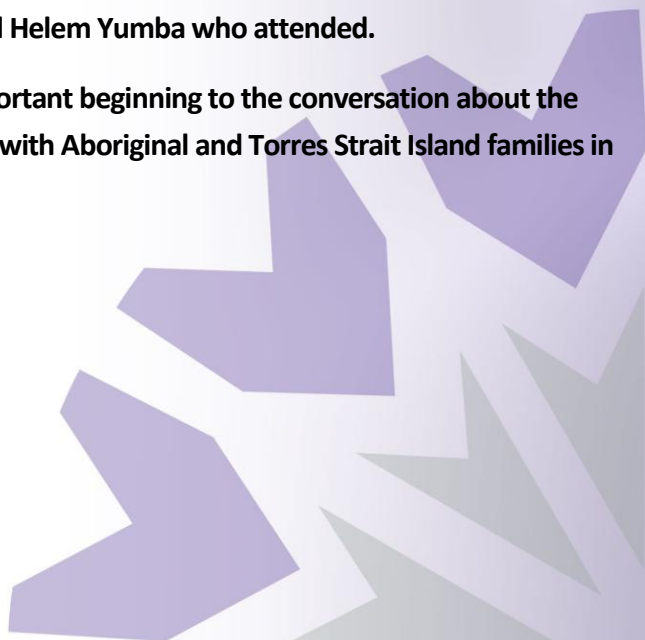

Important Notice: Family Law Pathways Network.

Dear Central Queensland Family Law Pathways Members,

I am writing to inform you that CatholicCare Central Queensland received formal advice from the Attorney-General's Department (the Department) on 1 May 2026 that funding for the Family Law Pathways Networks (FLPN) program will cease from 30 June 2026. I appreciate that news of this decision is disappointing for us all. The Department has emphasised that the decision to cease funding for the FLPN is part of a broader shift toward a renewed focus on front-line service delivery areas. It is not a judgement or reflection on the services we have provided. I would like to acknowledge the significant contribution that our network, and each of you, has made in supporting families and family law professionals by strengthening collaboration across our region.

CatholicCare Central Queensland remains strongly committed to the intent and impact of this work. In the coming months, CatholicCare will be actively exploring potential opportunities to continue or evolve the valuable connections and initiatives established through the FLPN. I welcome the opportunity to keep you and our network members informed and involved in these discussions as they progress. If you or any of our network members would prefer not to receive further communication or updates from CatholicCare in relation to this work beyond the cessation of the FLPN program, that preference will of course be respected. I will continue to keep you updated as further information becomes available. In the meantime, thank you again for your ongoing contribution and support.
